


Recent Arrivals


Here are some ideas for projects:


Grow native plants in a garden at home or at school.

Search for all the native plants growing in the school grounds. Find out their names and make name tags to go beside each plant.




Collect magazine photos of native and/or introduced plants and animals and glue these

- Useful and Harmful Plants and Animals Introduced into New Zealand.




